All Souls Women Composers Initiative

Ask someone to name a few famous composers of classical music, and they're not likely to say to a woman's name. Women have largely been excluded from the canons of music that have formed in Europe and America over the last two centuries.

The fact that artistic canons are shaped by larger sociopolitical forces means that they reproduce wider patterns of gendered oppression. This effect, moreover, is circular: to commend, study, or merely perform a canonic work is to re-inscribe the very authority and value that had made it seem worthy of commendation, study, or performance.

Such cycles are hard to break without conscious interventions, so in 2019 the All Souls Music Department raised funds to support the addition to our music library of twenty-one works by women. All of these pieces will make an appearance during the 2019–2020 choral season; they are indicated in the music list by the color red and by the symbol †. With music composition remaining an extremely male-dominated field, we hope that purchasing and performing music by women will help fight that inequity.
